Loudenne is known as the pink Château, independent and family-owned, with a strong history since its construction in 1670. An exceptional terroir and landscape just on the side of the Gironde estuary – only the greatest grands crus vineyards are located on the riverside of the this estuary on hills filled with gravel carried by the river.

To preserve this exceptional terroir, landscapes, and rich biodiversity, Loudenne is certified organic and HVE3 (High Environmental Value Level 3 certification).



### LE CHÂTEAU MÉDOC 2016

The flagship wine benefits from an exceptional terroir: two gravelly hills that slope gently down to the banks of the Gironde, reflecting the sun rays, reducing the risk of frost and helping the grapes to ripen. This privileged terroir contributes to the unique complexity and finesse of Château Loudenne's wines.

53% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot,  
2% Cabernet Franc  
Aged 12 to 16 months in French oak barrels.

### LE CHÂTEAU BLANC 2018

The oldest white Bordeaux wine of the Médoc region, sourced from plots closest to the Gironde estuary since 1880. This iconic Bordeaux white blends both oak and stainless steel-aged Sauvignon blanc and Sémillon to produce a wine that is lively and well-balanced.

77% Sauvignon Blanc, 23% Sémillon  
Fermented and aged for 5 to 6 months in  
French oak barrels. No malolactic fermentation.
